

## Align Financial Accountability Volunteer

Align's Ugandan ministry partners provide financial accountabilities (statements showing how and where funds were used) to ensure our donor's intentions are being met, understand the costs of our activities, minimize the potential for fraud and understand potential future impacts of exchange rates and inflation. Financial Accountability Volunteers will work in concert with the Align CFO and Ugandan ministry partners to review these accountabilities and ensure they are correct and accurate. They may also project or scale existing data to provide insight into the effects of changes or costs of derivative activities. Key review activities include ensuring:

- All accountabilities are mathematically correct
- All Align funding is accounted for
- Consistent and correct exchange rate usage
- Ugandan account balance funding is at an appropriate level
- Consistent expense categorization
- Expenses are consistent with funding intent.
- Projecting or scaling accountability data to provide insight into changes or derivative activities as needed

The role is scope and time flexible and tailored to Volunteer's skills, availability, and experience. Initial assignments will include working on projects with an Align Management Team member. Microsoft Excel proficiency is required. The role can be performed from your home or other locations with a computer, phone, and internet access.
